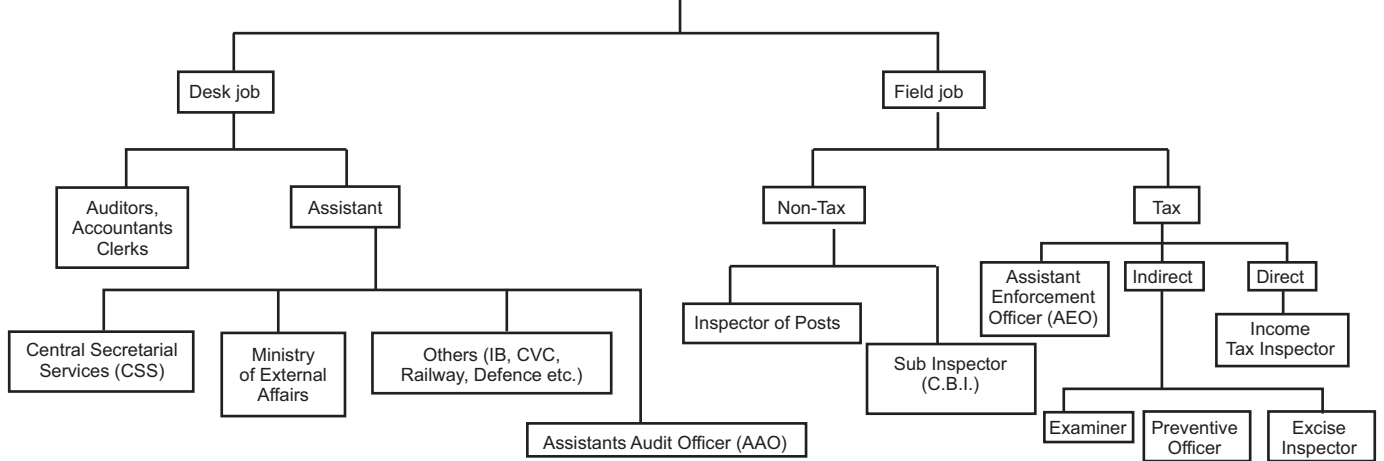

Analysis of CLAT Exam Pattern

Passage-based questions- The question paper, not including the Quantitative Techniques section, will have passages of 300-400 words each. Questions will be asked from these passages.

Quantitative section : Instead of passages, this section will have questions based on "short sets of facts or proportions, graphs, or other textual, pictorial, or diagrammatic representations of numerical information."

Descriptive section : There is no subjective/descriptive/essay writing section in CLAT UG and CLAT LLM. It has been dropped from the CLAT pattern for now.

Standard of questions : The undergraduate exam will be of 10+2 standard.

Skills tested - The paper will test the candidate on a number of parameters, including their ability to read, think critically, and do analytical thinking.

Total number of questions and marking scheme - CLAT UG will have 150 objective-type questions, while the LLM paper will have 120 questions. Each question will be of one mark, while for an incorrect answer, 0.25 marks will be deducted.

RRB NTPC stands for Railway Recruitment Board's Non-Technical Popular Categories. It is a national-level examination that is conducted to recruit graduates and undergraduates for the post of Non-Technical Popular Categories (NTPC) in various Zonal Railways and Production Units of Indian Railways.

Eligibility /

● Educational Qualification

Candidate must have passed class 12th if he wants to apply for the undergraduate level posts, whereas, Graduation degree from a recognised university must be attained in order to apply for Graduate level posts.

● Age Limit :

For Graduate level posts, the candidate should age between 18 to 33 years, whereas, 18 to 30 years is the age limit for undergraduate level posts.
